

3-TRACK DISABILITIES

- **AK** – above the knee amputation
- **BK** – below the knee amputation. Generally with greater than a 4” stump, can ski with prosthesis.
- **HEMIPELVECTOMY** – most severe. Amputation of half the hip and corresponding leg.
- **HIP DISARTICULATION** (removal at the joint). Removal of one leg.
- **SYMES AMPUTATION** – amputation at ankle joint. Can 2-track. Boot fitting issues.
- **UNILATERAL** –amputations on same side.
- **BILATERAL** – amputations on both sides.
- **CANCER**
- **CONGENITAL ANOMALIES** – Thalidomide, substance abuse, arthrogyrosis.
- **DIABETES** – vascular complications
- **ARTHRITIS**
- **GANGRENE**
- **POLIO** – circulatory impairment = cold = frostbite.
- **POST-POLIO** – progressive. Both neuromuscular and orthopedic.
- **DEVELOPMENTAL / MUSCULAR DISEASES**
- **KNEE INJURY**
- **TRAUMA** – 1 leg weak or non-functioning.
